
With the ever-changing state of COVID-19, the Summer 2020 Program Guide will not be printed and mailed to your homes this season.

Dear Residents:

I originally prepared a different introductory letter for this Summer 2020 program guide, but in light of current circumstances, I decided it best to modify my message. No one imagined that we would be in these unprecedented times of social distancing. Not being able to have face to face contact with our residents is hard for all of us.


With the ever-changing state of COVID-19, this program guide will not be printed or mailed to your homes. Instead, in the effort of providing you with timely, accurate information we have chosen to present the summer

brochure only on our website. We understand this may not be some residents preferred method of accessing the information, however, it allows us to assure that the information is more up-to-date and not confusing.

As of this date, the Park District has furloughed most of our part-time and seasonal staff due to the fact that the programs and facilities where they work are not able to operate. This was a terribly difficult decision, but, as stewards of your tax dollars the board and administration felt that this was the most responsible decision for our community. This does not mean they won't come back. It means that they will return after the Executive Order has been lifted and it is financially feasible to do so.

Since our closing on March 16, staff has provided some free programs on social media as a means of staying connected and engaged with all of you. We've reached out to our participants, including our preschoolers and beloved senior citizens. Now, that the Governor's Executive Order has been extended to at least April 30, we are changing directions and will be presenting some fee-based internet programming options for our residents to enjoy. Registration will be done online, and programs will be held in live and video format on social media, and through email links. By signing up for fee-based programs you will be able to learn a new skill, keep your mind challenged and in some cases, interact with others. This programming measure will also support small businesses by allowing us to use some of our contractual partners, and in some cases justify bringing back staff who have been furloughed to teach these programs. The only way we can do this is if we have fees to support their wages.

Our mission has been to serve the community with quality recreational experiences that provide a fun and healthy lifestyle. While we are having to create new ways to fulfill that mission, we are still as dedicated to carrying it out as we were before. We know it's not the same as learning and playing side-by-side, but one thing that hasn't changed is that recreation still provides respite from stress and enhances our bodies; physically, mentally and emotionally. We need that now, more than ever. We appreciate your support during this time. We wish you and your families all the best.

## THE WOODLANDS RENTAL OPTIONS

#### The Woodlands at White Oaks Park

Officially opened on Saturday, November 23, 2019, The Woodlands at White Oaks Park, a 2,500 square foot indoor/outdoor recreation program and event facility, is now available for community, family and corporate rentals. This facility, set in the midst of the 19-acre White Oaks Park located at 111 S. Wood Dale Road, will serve as a refreshing respite away from the busy urban environment in which we live. The natural surroundings provide a feeling of escape and serenity and will allow for focus and rehabilitation. This is the perfect spot to host a party, reunion or celebration for your family and friends or a team-building event, training or meeting for your staff, committee or business.

#### Hickory Room (Large Gathering Space)

Featuring 18' foot ceilings as well as floor to ceiling windows facing the beautiful serenity of the park, natural wood, state-of-the-art lighting and a large temperature-regulating fan, the Hickory Room provides a cozy, comfortable atmosphere for any gathering. A kitchenette with ample counter space perfect for serving food and beverages, microwave, refrigerator, and dishwasher are also available. Six-foot tables and chairs are included in the rental, with set-ups available in banquet and theatre style. For larger groups, renters may consider the Winnebago Room as a food and beverage service area, or for additional seating. A discounted rate is available for the second room.

#### The Winnebago Room (Meeting Room)

All are invited to visit The Beach Waterpark, even if you have not purchased a season pass! Please note the daily admission fees listed below. Children two (2) years and under are FREE when accompanied by an adult 18 years and older. No refunds are issued due to inclement weather.

#### **Daily Admission Guest Coupon Books**

Do you have family members or friends visiting over the summer? This punch card is great for out-of-town guests! Each punch card entitles you to ten individual admissions. One admission punch per person, per visit. Punch cards will be available April 6.

\$70 = 10 admissions into the Waterpark

#### Adult Swim Punch Card

Adult swim times require a Waterpark pass membership or punch card. With a Waterpark annual pass, you can attend Adult Swim as many times as you wish. With a punch card purchase, you can attend up to ten visits per card. Punch cards can be purchased at the front desk at the Recreation Complex. Please see a Waterpark Manager upon each visit to punch your card. \$50 = Ten visits

- 1. A family must consist of persons permanently residing at one address. PROOF OF RESIDENCY FOR EVERY MEMBER OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD MUST BE PROVIDED. A DOCTOR'S BILL FOR CHILDREN, SCHOOL REPORT CARD OR SCHOOL ID WITH CHILD'S NAME OR LIBRARY CARD ARE ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION. If you have purchased a pass in the past, you will only need to provide the above information for any additions. The Wood Dale Park District reserves the right to request additional identification for proof of age or residential status.
- 2. Photo ID cards: Waterpark passes must be purchased or renewed for the upcoming season. Please HOLD ON to your photo ID cards as cards will be updated when payment is made. You must present your Photo ID to the Admissions Desk upon entering The Beach Waterpark. If you do not have your ID, you will be charged the daily admission fee. Children two years old and younger do not need to purchase a waterpark pass, and do not need a photo ID as long as they are accompainied by a paying adult.
- All household members three years of age and older will need to have their photo taken for a waterpark pass photo ID upon purchasing passes for the summer.
- 4. A lost, stolen or damaged season pass ID card must be replaced at a cost of \$15. Replacement passes are available at the Recreation Complex.
- NO REFUNDS will be given for season passes for any reason.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

#### Detailed rules also posted at The Beach Waterpark

- Children ten years and under will not be permitted into The Beach Waterpark without a parent or adult guardian.
- 2. The Children's Water Playground may be used by children seven years and younger who are accompanied and supervised by a parent or an adult guardian (18 years or older).
- 3. Food, gum, or tobacco will not be permitted. Plastic water bottles and baby bottles are permitted.
- All patrons are required to take a shower before entering The Beach Waterpark.
- 5. No shoes may be worn on the deck
- Except on specified days, NO floatation devices will be permitted, including suits with floatation devices.
- Running, pushing, dunking or other boisterous play will not be tolerated.
- 8. Always obey lifequards and staff.
- Diving or entering the pool head-first is not permitted at any time.
- The Wood Dale Park District reserves the right to eject any individual involved in acts of misconduct. Length of ejection will be determined at the time of ejection.
- 11. All people are required to read and obey any posted rules and signs, including water slide, Waterpark, and spa rules. Failure to read and obey these rules may result in a warning or Waterpark ejection or pass revocation.
- 12. All patrons must wear swimwear. No street clothes allowed in The Beach Waterpark. Observers must be barefoot and are required to stay in the concession area.
- Admission to The Beach Waterpark may be refused to any person showing signs of or having any contagious or infectious conditions or diseases.
- Infant carriers are allowed in The Beach Waterpark. Strollers are allowed in the grass area only.
- 15. Children who are not completely toilet-trained shall wear tight-fitting rubber or plastic pants, which are approved by the DuPage County Health Department.
- To prevent a safety hazard, lotion or oils must be applied in the locker room or grassy area only. Any lotion left on the deck will be removed.
- The Wood Dale Park District and its staff are not responsible for lost or stolen items

#### BEACH WATERPARK CLOSURES

On occasion, The Beach Waterpark will be closed due to the following:

- Air temperature falling below 68 degrees
- Lightning and/or thunder in the area, rain and other threatening weather conditions
- Less than 20 people in the Waterpark

NO REFUNDS will be given due to inclement weather.

The Waterpark will be closed for swim meets, with dates posted at the pool. The pool may be closed due to mechanical reasons.

#### Children's Water Playground

The Children's Water Playground may be used by children seven years and younger who are accompanied by a parent or an adult guardian (18 years or older). This adult must stay with the child in the Water Playground at all times. Children with diapers will NOT be permitted in the Water Playground area UNLESS wearing tightly fifting rubber or plastic pants, approved by the DuPage County Health Department, are worn over the diapers.



## THE BEACH WATERPARK

## PERSONAL FLOATATION DEVICES

The Beach Waterpark does not allow personal flotation or swim suits with built-in floatation devices (water wings, etc) to be used in the water unless necessary for persons who are seizure prone or eligible through the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Exception: please see life jackets description. Personal floatation devices can give a false sense of security because people believe that the floatation device will prevent them or their child from drowning. A weak swimmer may move into water over their head, lose their device and panic. This policy is intended to provide a safe experience at our facility. The above recommendations were provided by the Park District Risk Management Association (PDRMA) Aquatic Safety Guidelines developed by aquatic professionals in llinois and from the result from PDRMA's accident and drowning investigations.

#### Life Jackets

Life jackets are available at the facility. Personal life jackets are permitted with approval from the manager. Life jackets must be USCG approved. A photo ID is required to borrow a life jacket and will be returned after use. Life jackets are free to use.

#### Water Slide Rules

- You must be 48" tall and be able to swim one width of the pool
- You must enter and exit the flume, feet first. Only one person may slide at a time.
- No stopping or standing in the flume.
- No diving from the end of the flume.
- Metal objects, jewelry, chains or watches are not permitted on slides.
- Pregnant women are not permitted on the slide
- No glasses or sunglasses on the slide.
- No running on stairs or around pool deck.
- No double-riding.

#### RENITALS

The Beach Waterpark offers two rental options:

#### Option 1: Private:

The Beach Waterpark can be rented during hours when the Waterpark is not open to the public, conducting swim lessons, or conducting Swim Team Practices or Swim Team Meets. The Waterpark may be rented:

- 7:30 9:30 pm every day, except Wednesday.
- 8:00 -10:00 pm every day
- Saturday and Sunday mornings before noon, when

The focus will be on promoting water safety knowledge and practices, aquatic adjustment and swimming readiness skills, as well as fun and enjoyment in the water. Adult or parent accompaniment in the water is REQUIRED for the Parent/Child program and is OPTIONAL for the preschool program. Each lesson is 30 minutes in length. Missed lessons cannot be made up. A certificate is awarded to the participants at the completion of the class. Please note that a late fee of \$5 will be applied if not registered the Friday before the next session starting.

#### **Program Fees/Payments**

A \$30 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of your initial registration. Unless paid in full, payments are spread out evenly over the course of nine months. ## RAINBOW PLAYSCHOOL

#### Two-Year-Old Program

This program is a great way to introduce your child to a preschool setting. This class focuses on becoming comfortable with separation from parent or guardian, encouraging independence, learning to share, and fostering communication skills. Fine and gross motor skills are enhanced through manipulatives, art, gym time, and group activities. Children do not need to be toilet-trained.

#### Three-Year-Old Program

This program provides children with a wide variety of learning experiences in a more structured environment. Children will learn through play and will create projects to enhance their knowledge. ## YOUTH PROGRAMS



The Extended School Program is designed to provide children in Kindergarten – 5th Grade with supervised recreational activities in a safe environment before school, after school, and on most days that school is not in session. The program is held at the Recreation Complex for participants in Kindergarten – 2nd Grades, and Westview Elementary for 3rd – 5th graders. Participants in Kindergarten – 2nd grades will be bused to the Recreation Complex in the afternoon. Bussing is provided by School District #7. In the morning, participants are bused to their respective schools. Participants are required to live within the School District #7 boundaries in order to register for Extended School Program.

#### Registration

Registration Packets for Extended School are Available for pick up at the Recreation Complex or online at www.wdparks.org, Mail or fax registration will not be permitted. Registration must be done in person by an adult. A parent guide with additional information will be distributed to parents at the time of registration. An additional \$30 nonrefundable registration fee and a full month payment to hold your child's spot in each program will be due at the time of registration. The initial payment will be applied toward your final month in May 2021. Registrations taken for August will require two payments in August 2020 and May 2021. Registrations after the start date will require supervisor approval and up to two business days for processing.

#### **ePACT**

ePACT Network will be used to collect all medical and emergency contact information electronically. After registration is complete, you will receive an email invitation to create your free account and complete the necessary forms for Extended School. Participants without their ePACT forms submitted digitally before their first day of Extended School will not be accepted into the program.

#### Refunds

Parents requesting a refund will be expected to fill out a refund request form in person. Refunds will be prorated based on the date the refund form was completed. A \$5 service fee per child will apply to all refunds. Fees will not be prorated for absences from the Extended School Program.

#### **Payment Plan**

A monthly payment plan is offered to assist parents with the financial responsibilities of the Extended School Program. To keep the monthly payment consistent, the total program fee is spread out evenly over ten payments. Payments do not reflect the monthly cost of the program. Payment plans will require a credit or debit card to be linked to the payment plan throughout the duration of the program. The payments are due on the first of each month and will be automatically debited from the credit card. If the scheduled payment fails, the customer will be subject to a \$15 late fee per child.

#### School Days Off

Kindergarten – 6th grade

We offer a program for the half and full days off of school. Activities will include: games, crafts, free play and trips. Children should bring a sack lunch and a drink. The School Days Off program is available to students in Kindergarten – 6th grades. Spots are limited, so it is suggested to register as early as possible for any days you may need throughout the year. There is no After School Bunch on half day off days.





Rob was born and raised in Wood Dale, and Salt Creek Golf Club is actually one of the courses where he learned how to play the game. Rob has 20 plus years' experience working and providing golf instruction at top ranked facilities like Medinah Country Club, Omni Tucson National, Marriot Chardonnay Club, Dick's Sporting Goods, and Bridges of Poplar Creek CC. Rob graduated from the Pro Golf Management Program at Ferris State University in Big Rapids, MI. Rob is a Class A PGA Professional Member of the Illinois PGA and the PGA of America.

Summary of Rob's Teaching Philosophy

Rob will start the lesson by interviewing his students with basic questions like: What goals and expectations do they have for themselves, and from taking lessons? Has their equipment been fit for them? Do they have any physical limitations? These are critical factors that help understand from where each individual is coming. Rob is a big proponent of focusing on the basics like grip, setup, stance, posture, alignment, ball position, face angle of the clubhead at impact and swing path. Students will learn a basic understanding of how all these factors effect ball flight. Students will also be given drills to help them improve and will receive a basic understanding of how they can self-correct their swing faults. Slow motion video is used to help see key swing factors, and more importantly this will help the students identify exactly what is happening.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **Wood Dale Park District**

The Wood Dale Park District is a separate municipal agency established for the purpose of providing parks, facilities, and recreational programs for the community. The Park District is responsible for the maintenance, operation and administration of parks, park facilities and programs under its jurisdiction. The Park District is governed by five elected commissioners, who set policies and approve budgets for the operation of the Park District. Regular Park Board meetings are held on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm, in the Recreation Complex at 111 E. Foster Ave. Residents are invited to attend and are welcome to make suggestions or provide constructive comments to improve the parks, programs or facilities. Any changes, cancellations or additional meetings will be postd at the facility or on the wdparks.org homepage.

#### **Corporate Rate Policy**

In August 2008, the Park District Board approved a corporate rate policy for Fitness Classes, some adult classes, camps, pool and Fitness Studio individual adult memberships. To receive the corporate rates listed in the selected programs, individuals must meet the following requirements upon registration: Must be employed by a company residing within the Wood Dale Park District or City of Wood Dale boundaries, be able to provide verified employment on company letterhead or pay stub and present a valid photo ID. We are pleased to offer this discounted rate to our Wood Dale businesses and corporations so you may take advantage of our quality programs and facilities. Registration for businesses will begin on the same day as the registration dates for residents.

#### **Insurance Policy**

Wood Dale Park District assumes no responsibility for personal injuries or loss of personal belongings while using District facilities or parks. It is recommended that anyone enrolled in a specialized program, sports activity, or using the facilities and parks provide this coverage within their own family or individual insurance program. their own family insurance program.

## Equal Access for Persons with Disabilities & Special Accommodations

It is the practice of the Wood Dale Park District to welcome individuals of all abilities to participate in Park District services, programs and activities and to visit parks and park facilities. If you or a family member need special accommodations or have a disability and are interested in participation in or attending a Park District program or activity or coming to a facility. or if you or a family member require publications or other materials of the Park District in special format (e.g., Braille, audio cassette, large print), please advise our staff at 630-595-9333.

To assist the Park District in making these accommodations, we invite any person with a special need to contact the Park District Staff prior to you or your family member's intended participation or attendance to discuss the necessary accommodation(s). This will help lead to a smooth inclusion. Besides the programs listed in our brochure, the Park District also provides additional specialized services for people with disabilities through NEDSRA (Northeast DuPage Special Recreation Association), an extension of the Park District. Feel free to call NEDSRA at 630.620.4500.

#### **Inclusion In Park District Programs**

Inclusion provides opportunities for individuals with and without special needs to experience recreation together at the Wood Dale Park District. Inclusion looks at the needs, interests and abilities of the individuals instead of focusing on their special needs.

#### Parents/Volunteers/Spectators Code of Conduct

Parents, volunteers and spectators are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times while participating in any program, event or activity with the Wood Dale Park District. It is recommended that parents discuss with their children that activities are planned for groups and while their child may wish not to participate in a specific activity, he/she is still expected to make an effort to be a part of the program. The following guidelines are designed to provide safe and enjoyable activities for all participants. Additional rules may be developed for particular programs and athletic programs as deemed necessary by staff.

Parents/Volunteers/Spectators shall:

- Show respect to all participants and staff, and take directions from staff.
- 2. Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
- 3. Refrain from causing bodily harm to self, other participants or staff.
- 4. Show respect to equipment, supplies and facilities.
- 5. Take direction from program staff and supervisors.

The Wood Dale Park District, its instructors, supervisors and administrative staff, reserves the right to suspend, expel or deny participation in or viewing of any program, event or facility to any person whose behavior materially interferes, or disrupts the quality of those offerings, the enjoyment of them by other participants, or the ability of staff to conduct or manage the activities or facility.

#### **Participant Code of Conduct**

Wood Dale Park District promotes the concept of "equal fun for everyone." No eligible participant shall, on the basis of race, sex, creed, national origin, or disability be denied equal access to programs, activities, services or benefits, or be limited in the exercise of any right, privilege, advantage or opportunity. However, Wood Dale Park District participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. The Park District's behavior code has been developed for specific programs and athletic leagues as deemed necessary by staff.

Participants shall:

- Show respect to all participants and staff, and take directions from staff.
- 2. Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
- 3. Refrain from causing bodily harm to self, other participants or staff.
- 4. Show respect to equipment, supplies and facilities.

Participants who do not conform to these rules may be asked to leave the program, or may be dropped from the class, or have their participation privileges suspended for a periof of time.

#### **Park District Resident**

A Wood Dale Park District resident is someone who has their permanent residence within the Park District taxing boundaries. Even though you may own property within the Park District boundaries, you are not considered a Park District resident unless you reside therein. If you are a first time registrant, you will need to provide proof of residency for all members within your household. A house contract, personal check, utility bill, etc. are acceptable forms of proof. A school report card, school photo ID, doctor's bill with the child's name and address on it, library card (for Waterpark passes only), medical insurance card, etc, are acceptable forms of proof for children. Note: Having a Wood Dale address does not guarantee Park District residency status, as the Wood Dale Park District boundaries are not contiguous with the City of Wood Dale.

#### Non-Resident Registration Policy

Program participants residing outside the boundaries of the Wood Dale Park District may be required to pay an additional registration fee for trips and programs.

#### Non-Resident Member Fee

Those Wood Dale addresses not in the taxing district of the Wood Dale Park District can pay a yearly "Membership Tax". The fee of \$50 per year per household enables you to receive the same resident benefits that a Wood Dale Park District resident receives for all programs at the Recreation Complex.

#### Parent/Staff Program Responsibility

The Wood Dale Park District Staff are responsible for program participants during designated program hours ONLY. Parents should be prompt in both drop-off and pick-up times. In the case of back to back classes, an instructor may not be able to wait at the door.

#### **Return Check Policy**

We will gladly accept personal checks in payment of registration fees. If for any reason a check is returned to our office marked "NSF" we will contact you. You will then be required to submit a full cash payment, as well as a \$15.00 service charge. Class privileges will be suspended and new registrations will not be accepted until payment is received. Restitution must be made in any form of payment except check. Checks will not be sent through a second time. If the Park District receives a second "NSF" check from the same person, additional fees will be charged and checks will no longer be accepted as payment.

#### Photo & Video Policy

Photos and video footage are periodically taken of people participating in Wood Dale Park District programs or activities, using District facilities or properties. Please be aware that by registering for a class or program, participating in an activity, attending an event, or using District facilities or properties, you authorize the District to use these photos and video footage for promotional purposes in District publications, advertising, marketing materials, brochures, banners, posters, signs, event flyers, social media (including Facebook, YouTube, Instagram, Twitter, and other social media sites operated

by the District), Twitter, and other social media sites operated by the District), and the District's website without additional prior notice or permission and without any compensation to you. All photos and videos are property of Wood Dale District. If you choose not to have a photo or video taken, please indicate in writing at the Recreation Complex front desk prior to participation in the program or event, and alert the person taking photographs on site.

#### **Class Refund Policy**

Full refunds are granted without penalty for:

- A refund initiated by the Park District (i.e. canceled program, low enrollment)
- Injury or illness with a doctor's note prior to the start of the program. Once a program has started, a pro-rated refund will be issued. A doctor's note must be received within seven days of the date of the missed class.
- Report to military duty. A note must be received within 10 days of the date of the notice.

Refunds will be granted if received at least one working day (Mon – Fri) prior to the scheduled starting date of the program minus a \$5.00 processing fee. If the refund request is submitted on the day of the program start date, a pro-rated fee minus the \$5.00 processing fee will be issued.

Once a program has begun (per approval of the supervisor), refunds will be granted, minus a \$5.00 processing fee and only a pro-rated fee will be issued for classes that have not already been held.

After the midpoint of a program, no refunds will be issued except in the case of illness/injury, when accompanied by a doctor's note.

Once a program has concluded. NO REFUNDS will be issued.

Preschool, camps, league deposits, membership payments, contracted programs, extended school programs or trips are considered separately. Please call 630.595.9333 for specific policies. Refunds DO NOT apply to the golf course, food and beverages, golf banquet deposits, pool passes, and facility rentals. Refund request forms may be completed at the Recreation Complex Front Desk. You may also phone in a refund request at 630.595.9333. Please allow up to three weeks for processing.

#### **Trip Refund Policy**

If you wish to cancel out of any trips, you must give the Park District at least one week's notice. At that point, if the Park District is able to resell your ticket, you will be issued a refund minus a \$5.00 processing fee. If the Park District is unable to resell your ticket, you will forfeit your complete registration fee.

#### Vandalism


